## Refunds and Substitutions

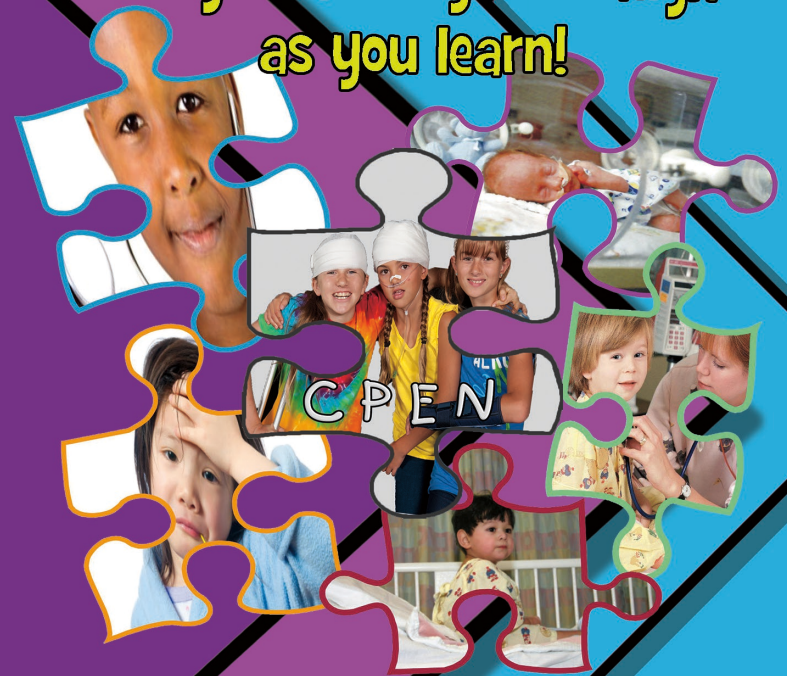
