

CHOOSE YOUR CERTIFICATION



Diverse Certifications to Help Your Department Thrive

BCEN offers five unique certifications in everything from transport to pediatrics. Your nurses likely already know where their interests and abilities lie, but they may need some guidance in deciding which certification is the right fit for them ... and for your organization.

All certifications share some key facts. Here's a rundown of what you need to know, no matter what credentials your nurses choose:

ELIGIBILITY



Nurses must hold a current, unrestricted Registered Nurse license in the U.S. or its territories prior to taking the exam.



A nursing certificate that is equivalent to a Registered Nurse in the U.S. is also acceptable.



Two years' experience in area of specialization is recommended, but not required.

PRICING



The full cost of each exam is \$370, and can be paid by individual nurses or by their facility.



Discounts are available through professional organizations with membership.



Discounted bulk vouchers can be purchased through the **BCEN® Voucher Program**.



CEN | Certified Emergency Nurse

Working in an emergency care setting and demonstrating knowledge and expertise across the emergency spectrum, the CEN® certification is the foundational emergency specialty certification.



Discounts are available via membership in the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CFRN | Certified Flight Registered Nurse

Flight nurses work in a unique environment, transporting critically ill and injured patients in the air, getting them where they need to be quickly and safely.



Discounts are available via membership in the Air & Surface Transport Nurses Association (ASTNA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CPEN | Certified Pediatric Emergency Nurse

The CPEN® certification is designed for nurses working in an emergency setting who wish to demonstrate clinical expertise with the special needs of infants and children.



Discounts are available via membership in the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CTRN | Certified Transport Registered Nurse

Grounded in excellence, the CTRN provides the expertise in transporting critically ill and injured patients safely and efficiently in a ground transport vehicle.



Discounts are available via membership in the Air & Surface Transport Nurses Association (ASTNA). Final cost for members is \$230.



TCRN | Trauma Certified Registered Nurse

Trauma nurses provide the utmost care to injured patients, demonstrating expertise across the continuum of trauma care, including injury prevention, prehospital care, acute care, rehabilitation and reintegration into society.



Discounts are available via membership in Society of Trauma Nurses (STN). Final cost for members is \$230.

Step One: Countdown to Launch

Certification success begins with careful planning. Nurses can sign up for a free account at <u>BCEN.org</u>. Once they've selected their certification, they will be prompted to submit an application. After BCEN has determined their eligibility and received payment, they will move on to the next step.



Step Two: The Journey Begins

Candidates have 90 days to schedule and take their exams. They can choose to sit for an in-person exam at any PSI testing facility, or opt for live remote proctoring via PSI, utilizing their own computer. We recommend scheduling and taking the exam as quickly as possible.



Step Three: Prepare for Success It's not just about showing up; it's about

slowing up and taking the time needed to succeed. BCEN offers helpful tools and tips for test preparation, but nothing is as key to a nurse's success as a <u>BCEN Practice Exam</u>. These exams are close to the real deal in delivery, content and scoring and will give nurses a flavor of the actual exam. We encourage administrators to support nurses in studying and purchasing a practice exam.



Step Four: The Big Moment

Your nurses are ready to soar. They'll need to bring along one valid form of ID when heading to the testing facility. After a brief orientation, they'll have three hours to complete the exam. With your support and encouragement, they'll be ready.



Step Five: The Future is Bright

Once a nurse has completed an exam, they will receive immediate results in the form of a print out at a testing center or on-screen if testing remotely. Results will also be sent via email the same day. If your nurse does not pass the exam, they will need your continued support as they make the decision to reapply.


