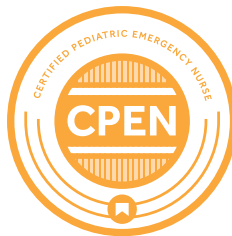

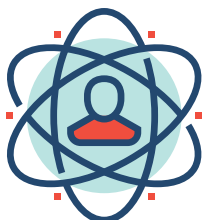

Certified emergency nurses are more likely to stay current on developing trends and technologies, putting them on the leading edge of your organization.

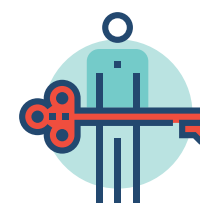

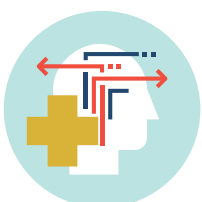

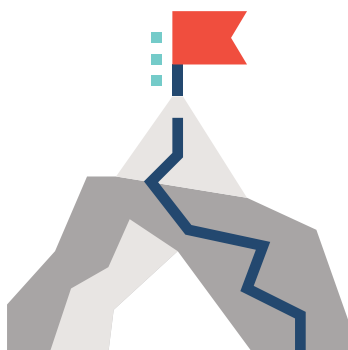

by Choosing the Certification That's Right for You!

You likely already know the specialization that best fits your unique interests and abilities. Or you may still be searching for the path that will lead to your passion. One thing is certain: when you love what you do, it shows. Making your case for certification begins by choosing your direction and setting your course. Explore each of our certifications to find the one in your specialty and then share with your supervisor to ignite your career.

All certifications share some key facts. Here's a rundown of what you need to know, no matter what certification you choose:

ELIGIBILITY



You must hold a current, unrestricted Registered Nurse license in the U.S. or its territories prior to taking the exam.



A nursing certificate that is equivalent to a Registered Nurse in the U.S. is also acceptable.



Two years' experience in your area of specialization is recommended, but not required.

PRICING



The full cost of each exam is \$370, and can be paid by individual nurses or by their supervisors.



Discounts are available through professional organizations with membership (details).



Discounted bulk vouchers can be purchased through the **BCEN® YES YOU CAN!** Employer Voucher Program.

BCEN'S FIVE EMERGENCY NURSING CERTIFICATIONS



CEN | Certified Emergency Nurse

Working in an emergency care setting and demonstrating knowledge and expertise across the emergency spectrum, the CEN® certification is the foundational emergency specialty certification.



Discounts are available via membership in the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CFRN | Certified Flight Registered Nurse

Flight nurses work in a unique environment, transporting critically ill and injured patients in the air, getting them where they need to be quickly and safely.



Discounts are available via membership in the Air & Surface Transport Nurses Association (ASTNA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CPEN | Certified Pediatric Emergency Nurse

The CPEN® certification is designed for nurses working in an emergency setting who wish to demonstrate clinical expertise with the special needs of infants and children.



Discounts are available via membership in the Emergency Nurses Association (ENA). Final cost for members is \$230.



CTRN | Certified Transport Registered Nurse

Similar to the CFRN®, but focused on ground transport, the transport nurse delivers care to the critically ill/injured while traveling in an ambulance. Expert transport care on the ground.



Discounts are available via membership in the Air & Surface Transport Nurses Association (ASTNA). Final cost for members is \$230.



TCRN | Trauma Certified Registered Nurse

Trauma nurses provide the utmost care to injured patients, demonstrating expertise across the continuum of trauma care, including injury prevention, prehospital care, acute care, rehabilitation and reintegration into society.



Discounts are available via membership in Society of Trauma Nurses (STN). Final cost for members is \$230.

Step One: Countdown to Launch

Certification success begins with careful planning. Sign up for your free account at [BCEN.org](https://www.bcen.org). Once you've chosen the certification that's right for you, we make it simple to submit your application. Once we've determined you're eligible to pursue board certification and we receive your payment, we'll get in touch with your next steps.



Step Two: The Journey Begins

Candidates have 90 days to schedule and sit for their exams at any of our Pearson VUE testing facilities. Choose the place and time that's right for you. We recommend scheduling your exam as quickly as possible.



Step Three: Prepare for Success

Step Four: You Got This

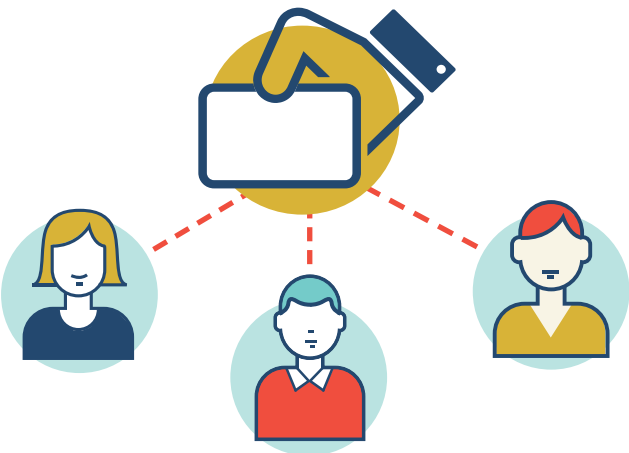

Step Five: Set Your Sights on the Future

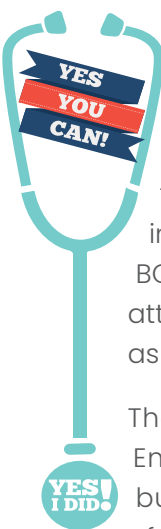
Once you've completed the exam, you'll receive results before leaving the testing facility. Results will also be sent directly to BCEN, where you can find them posted in your [My BCEN](#) account. In the event you do not pass, you'll receive a follow-up from BCEN on how to reapply.
