

TRANSFORMING TRANSPORT CARE BY AIR & GROUND



2023 was a banner year for transport specialty certification. The first ever value of CTRN and CFRN certification studies published in Air Medical Journal, the CTRN certification program was accredited by ABSNC, and the air medical transport community joined BCEN and flight nurses everywhere in celebrating the CFRN's 30th anniversary.

Recognizing Burn Nursing Specialty Expertise

With an official launch date of October 17, RNs and APRNs in the U.S. and Canada earning the CBRN were the among the world's first board certified burn nurses. We thank the dozens of expert contributors who served on the CBRN RDS Advisory Committee, as CBRN item writers, and on the new CBRN Exam Construction Review Committee for helping us be part of burn nursing history.

INCREASING EASE, ACCESS AND AFFORDABILITY

BCEN Vouchers were used for nearly 1/3 of initial certification applications in 2023, and the number of facilities purchasing vouchers rose by nearly 30%. To support maintenance of certification, BCEN reduced the cost of renewal by exam by 40% and renewal by CE attestation by 20%.
