The **CEN** and **CPEN** certification programs post growth as more new nurses chose adult and pediatric emergency nursing as their specialty, and the ranks of ED nurses who maintain their CEN for three and even four decades continues to rise.

8,075 TCRNs

Fueled by industry recognition that TCRNs add value across the trauma care continuum, the number of **TCRNs** tops 8,000 for the first time.

The number of nurses holding our flight and critical care ground transport credentials increases by 17% and 16%, respectively, with the **CFRN** annual growth rate more than tripling since 2020 and outpacing the fast-growing **CTRN** program for the first time in five years.

A little over a year after the worldwide launch, over 500 civilian and military burn nurses in the U.S. and Canada hold the **CBRN**.





Notable additions and accomplishments included:

- BCEN Learn team and dedicated subject matter experts have expanded BCEN Learn offerings by over 450% since 2021
- The Learn platform saw 35% more users and 25% more course registrations than in 2023, continuing its strong engagement with digital learners
- Over **30% more nurses** than last year saved 25% on continuing education by building their own bundles of courses, practice exams and games
- Over a dozen new free webinars on topics ranging from pediatric trauma to clinical mental wellness were added, with webinar registrations jumping 57% from 2023

Unlocking Success

BCEN Vouchers unlock success for organizations and nurses alike by creating a clear path to specialty certification at a significant savings.

A 25% annual rise in voucher sales highlights how hundreds of hospitals, health systems, and transport programs rely on the BCEN Voucher Program to certify and recertify more RNs while saving significantly



Case in point:

CFRN growth surpassed 17% in 2024, driven in part by a **doubling** of flight programs purchasing BCEN vouchers in recent years

- Hundreds of nurses—by purchasing as few as 3 vouchers for themselves or pooling with colleagues—also enjoy the program's 50% discount on initial certification and 34% off recertification
- **Test assurance vouchers**, which afford initial test takers a second attempt at a 40% discount, also saw significant growth

In 2024, BCEN voucher customers **saved a combined \$918,435** on initial exams, retests and recertifications.
